**ORDER SETTING OBJECTION DEADLINE
FOR RECEIVER'S PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION**

This matter has come before the Court on the Receiver's Motions to Approve Plan of Distribution [Doc. No. 118] and For Order Establishing Deadlines For Objections to the Plan [Doc. No. 119].

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT ALL OBJECTIONS TO THE RECEIVER'S PROPOSED CLAIM DETERMINATION AND PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION MUST BE FILED WITH THE CLERK OF THIS COURT NO LATER THAN JANUARY 31, 2017.

Any Claimant who wishes to object to the Receiver's proposed Claim Determination and/or Plan of Distribution must file an objection in writing with the Clerk of the District Court, United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Atlanta Division, Richard B. Russell Federal Building and Courthouse, 75 Ted Turner Drive, SW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303-3309. A copy of that objection must also be sent to the Receiver's office at 212 Church Street, Marietta, Georgia, 30060.

At a minimum, any Objection must contain the following:

(a) A caption setting forth the name of the Court, the names of the plaintiff and defendants, and the case number as noted above;

(b) The name of the Claimant, Claim Number, and a description of the basis for the amount of the Claim;

(c) A concise statement setting forth the reasons why the Claim should not be disallowed or modified as set forth in the Plan of Distribution, and/or why the Claim should be a different amount or in a different class, and/or why another distribution method would be more equitable for all Claimants;

(d) All documentation or other evidence of the Claim upon which Claimant will rely in opposing the Claim Determination and Plan of Distribution; and,

(e) The address to which the Receiver may send Claimant any reply to the Objection.

Claimant may, but is not required to, retain the services of an attorney to file any such Objection. If no Objection is received by the stated deadline, the Court may enter an Order approving of the Plan, including allowing or disallowing the Claims as set forth in the Plan of Distribution.
