

Georgia 30303-3309. A copy of the objection must also be sent to the Receiver's office, located at **212 Church Street, Marietta, Georgia, 30060.**

- The objection **must** contain:
 - A caption setting forth the name of the Court, the names of the Plaintiff and Defendants, and the case number, as noted above;
 - The name of the Claimant, Claim Number, and a description of the basis for the amount of the claim;
 - A concise statement setting forth the reasons why the Claim should not be disallowed or modified as set forth in the Plan of Distribution (Docs. No. [118], [132]) and/or why the Claim should be a different amount or in a different class, and/or why another distribution method would be more equitable for all Claimants;
 - Any documentation or other evidence of the Claim upon which the Claimant relies; and
 - An address to which the Receiver may send a reply to the objection.
- If no objection is received by the deadline set forth in this Order, the Claimant will have waived any objection to the Distribution Plan.

- The Receiver may file a response to any and all objections to the Distribution Plan no later than **14 days** after the deadline for filing objections has passed.

The Receiver's Amended Motion for Establishing a Deadline for Objection to the Receiver's Distribution Plan (Doc. No. [133]) is **GRANTED as modified by this Order**. The initial Motion for Establishing an Objection Deadline (Doc. No. [119]) is **DENIED as moot**.
